That idea proved effective and sparked an entire field. Today, community violence intervention programs exist in nearly every major U.S. city, many launched with our direct support and many more inspired by our work.

CVG continues to lead this field—advancing the approaches and strategies that can make a world without violence possible. We are building the future—one where every community has the power and support to stop violence in its tracks and reshape its trajectory.

## Strengthening Cities Across the United States

Cure Violence Global partners with cities across the United States to reduce shootings, prevent retaliation, and protect the communities most affected by violence. We equip local teams with proven public-health strategies that stop violence before it spreads—and save lives that might otherwise be lost.

Dozens of independent studies show reductions of 60% or more in shootings and killings. Recent results in Wichita, Kansas, saw a 79% drop in gun-related offenses and six months without a killing. In just one year, 282 conflicts were interrupted—including 40 potential retaliations.

## Transforming Safety in Latin America

Cure Violence Global has become a trusted partner throughout Latin America and the Caribbean, helping communities implement proven public-health strategies to stop violence at its source. Our work strengthens local capacity, builds frontline leadership, and adapts effective solutions to some of the most complex environments in the world.

Looking ahead, we are expanding across more communities in Mexico and Honduras, solidifying new efforts in Chile and Uruguay, and partnering with additional countries throughout the region. This is where innovation is meeting urgent need—and where life-saving strategies are changing what's possible for entire countries.

## Stopping Violence Against Women

Cure Violence Global is advancing a public-health approach to prevent gender-based violence developed with UNICEF and implemented across communities in Latin America and the Caribbean. This work protects women in some of the most dangerous environments and creates new pathways for safety and support.

We are now positioned to bring this expertise to cities in the United States and to strengthen community responses to domestic and family violence. By expanding this model, we are building a population-level strategy that stands with women, protects families, and confronts one of the most urgent—and preventable—forms of violence in the world.
